Journey: Olympia - Athens - Sofia - Bucharest - Moscow - Moscow - Leningrad - Tallinn Moscow - Minsk - Moscow - Kiev. Runners, cyclists, horsemen, and trains were used to bring the Olympic Flame to Moscow.

Caption: " Moskva Olimpiada 1980 " (Moscow Olympiad 1980). Plate formed with the Games logo and the Olympic rings, and the caption on the handle. Special reserve lamps. Two lots of flame dishes with a burning time of 1 and 24 hours. Diameter 240 and 750 mm.

Inscription: Olympia- thens-Sofia - Bucharest-Moscow. Designed by Alejandr Sergejev

- **End of Relay:** 19 July 1980
- **Runners:** 5.435
- **Distance (km):** 4.915
- **Total number of torches:** 6.200
- **Fuel:** mix of butane and propane
