



Journey: Olympia – Athens (Greece) (by airplane) Vienna (route nr. 1) Linz – Salzburg – Innsbruck (route nr. 2) Graz – Klagenfurt – Innsbruck (Austria). For the first time in a Winter Games, the Olympic torch was lit in ancient Olympia, Greece, then relayed to Innsbruck.
