



Journey: Olympia – Athens, (car), Athens – Vienna (airplane). In Austria a northern route (867 km) and a southern route (751 km) were used to bring the Olympic Flame to Innsbruck. Each convoy consisted of a “mobile dish” for the Olympic Flame, and a miner’s lamp (placed on a Mercedes roof). As a reminder of the Winter Olympics already held in Innsbruck, two flames were lit simultaneously by two Olympic champions of the 1964 Games.
