Journey: The torch is made of the following key elements: lightweight glass (symbolising winter and ice); old silver (the West, flowing water); very shiny silver (the heart, the speed of the athletes) and copper (fire, passion, the history of Utah). It was designed in the shape of a stalactite to symbolise winter sports and the theme chosen for these Games "Light the Fire Within". The silver grooves of the torch are evocative of the texture of pure ice. For the first time, the Olympic flame was made to spring up through a frosted glass orifice, thus symbolising the flame which burned within each one of the runners.
